
## MQA 2020 QAL Block #8 Dutchman's Puzzle



This block is perfect for trying the "No Waste Method" for making flying geese units.

## What you will need:

Fabric 1 (black)
Cut (1) square 7 ¼ x 7 ¼"

Fabric 2 (Print)
Cut (1) square 7 ¼ x 7 ¼"

Fabric 3 (White)
Cut (8) squares 3 7/8 x 3 7/8"

## **Block #8 Instructions**

Step 5

- Step 1 Draw your stitching lines on the wrong side of (4) of the smaller squares using a ruler and pencil. (The same way we did when making HST) Stitch just inside the drawn lines.
- Step 2 Cut in half. Press towards Fabric 3.
- Step 3 Sew the remaining smaller squares as shown. Stitch just inside the drawn lines.
- Step 4 Cut in half, Press towards fabric 3, remove dog ears, and trim to 3 ½ x 6 ½".

Repeat Steps 1-4 using Fabric #2

Step 5 – Sew the Fabric 2 geese to the top of the Fabric 1 geese. Press towards the top geese. This should measure 6 ½" square. Lay out the 4 blocks like the picture of the finished Dutchman's Puzzle block. Sew into a 4-patch.

Finished block will measure 12 1/2".
