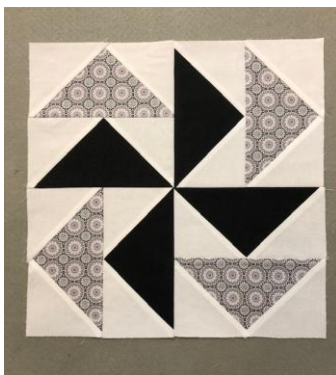

Block #8
Dutchman's Puzzle



This block is perfect for trying the "No Waste Method" for making flying geese units.

What you will need:

Fabric 1 (black)
Cut (1) square $7\frac{1}{4} \times 7\frac{1}{4}$ "

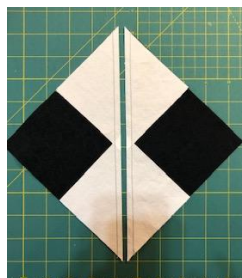
Fabric 2 (Print)
Cut (1) square $7\frac{1}{4} \times 7\frac{1}{4}$ "

Fabric 3 (White)
Cut (8) squares $3\frac{7}{8} \times 3\frac{7}{8}$ "

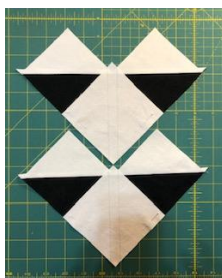
Block #8 Instructions

Step 1 – Draw your stitching lines on the wrong side of (4) of the smaller squares using a ruler and pencil. (The same way we did when making HST) Stitch just inside the drawn lines.

Step 2 - Cut in half. Press towards Fabric 3.

Step 3 - Sew the remaining smaller squares as shown. Stitch just inside the drawn lines.

Step 4 - Cut in half, Press towards fabric 3, remove dog ears, and trim to $3\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Repeat Steps 1-4 using Fabric #2

Step 5 – Sew the Fabric 2 geese to the top of the Fabric 1 geese. Press towards the top geese. This should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Lay out the 4 blocks like the picture of the finished Dutchman's Puzzle block. Sew into a 4-patch.

Finished block will measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
