Dutchman's Puzzle


This block is perfect for trying the "No Waste Method" for making flying geese units.

## What you will need:

Fabric 1 (black)
Cut (1) square $71 / 4 \times 7 \frac{1}{4}$ "

Fabric 2 (Print)
Cut (1) square $71 / 4 \times 71 / 4$ "

Fabric 3 (White)
Cut (8) squares $37 / 8 \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$

## Block \#8 Instructions

Step 1 - Draw your stitching lines on the wrong side of (4) of the smaller squares using a ruler and pencil. (The same way we did when making HST) Stitch just inside the drawn lines.
Step 2 - Cut in half. Press towards Fabric 3.
Step 3 - Sew the remaining smaller squares as shown. Stitch just inside the drawn lines.
Step 4 - Cut in half, Press towards fabric 3, remove dog ears, and trim to $31 / 2 \times 61 / 2 \prime$.

Repeat Steps 1-4 using Fabric \#2

Step 5 - Sew the Fabric 2 geese to the top of the Fabric 1 geese. Press towards the top geese. This should measure $61 / 2 \prime$ " square. Lay out the 4 blocks like the picture of the finished Dutchman's Puzzle block. Sew into a 4-patch.
